METAL

Large Scrap Metal

Self Stick Labels
Used Paper Plates
Tissue Paper
Gum / Candy Wrappers
Waxed Paper
Paper Cups
Paper Towels

PLASTIC

Plastic Bread / Storage Bags
Large Storage Bins
Plastic Wrap
Snack Bags
(chips, fruit snack pouches, etc.)
CD, DVD Packaging
Bubble Wrap
Plastic Silverware

Tips

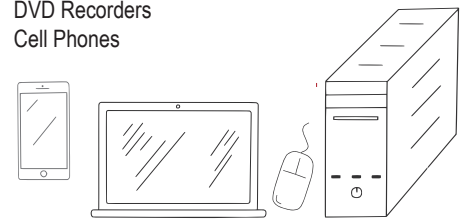
- 1 Break down all cardboard boxes.
